

Victorinox Cases/Pouches for 91mm Officer Knives

I have collected pouches over the years as I have Swiss Army Knives and have generally favored the more refined look of smooth leather over the Zermatt pouches which I do not own an example. Until recently the large heavy duty In the photographs below you will find some examples of the pouches that have been available in the past and that are now discontinued and some that are still available.



First Photograph: 1st & 2nd Pouches hold up to 7 layer Swiss Champ. The 3rd Pouch will hold up to 6 layer Champion. (None of these pouches have extra compartments like the SOS Pouches. All of the pouches in this photo are discontinued as far as I know and/or are not offered in the United States.)



Second Photograph: 1st - Original SOS Kit w/out Mini-Mag Solitaire, 2nd – SOS Kit with Mini-Mag Solitaire, 3rd – Double SOS Kit, One side for knife, other for provisions. (These SOS Kits are generally available for the Swiss Champ. However, I think the “Original” type was available for the Champion prior to the introduction of the Swiss Champ in 1986.)



Third Photograph: 1st Pouch, small size allows up to a 3 layer knife with a tight fit. The 2nd pouch holds up to a 6 layer Champion with a tight fit. The 3rd pouch holds up to a 7 layer Swiss Champ. (The second pouch has side compartments for very small diameter items. The third pouch is nylon and usually comes with knives less than 7 layers but will hold a Swiss Champ.)
